



WHAT'S THE BOTTOM LINE?

Youth Encounter's Team Sponsorship Program

Youth Encounter is a non-profit ministry organization that relies on offerings, grants and other contributions to fund Team Ministry. A part of the call to serve on Team Ministry with Youth Encounter is a commitment to raise financial support through the Sponsorship Program to help cover the cost of your Team experience.

Youth Encounter's Development Department gives you all the instructions, tools, and support you need to implement a fund raising plan. A successful program covers a full year of Ministry Team expenses, and even makes it possible to raise money beyond expenses.

YOUR COMMITMENT

Fund Raising

Your commitment, upon accepting a Letter of Call, is to gather prayer and financial support from family, friends, congregational members, and fraternal funding organizations. Each Team member is required to submit at least 60 names, addresses, and phone numbers of people Youth Encounter will contact (only names with complete information will be counted towards the 60). A personal note explaining why you are doing "Team" will be also be required. This will be used on the back of your sponsor letters to add a more personal touch.

The Development Department also helps you achieve your goal by suggesting other methods and sources of financial support in your community. We ask that you work to reach your goal as soon as possible, although many people continue to work towards their goal throughout the Team experience. We do not require any money up front.

Personal Expenses

Personal expenses for which you are responsible include:

- ◆ travel to and from Minneapolis, MN at the beginning and end of your tour
- ◆ health insurance premiums
- ◆ a pre-tour physical
- ◆ vacation expenses
- ◆ other miscellaneous costs like phone calls, clothes, etc.

Additional expenses for International Team members include a passport, a birth certificate and visa photos.

OUR COMMITMENT

Provide For Your Basic Needs

Youth Encounter and the people that you meet while on the road provide your basic needs: training and support, prayer, meals, housing, transportation and some toiletries.

Reimbursement

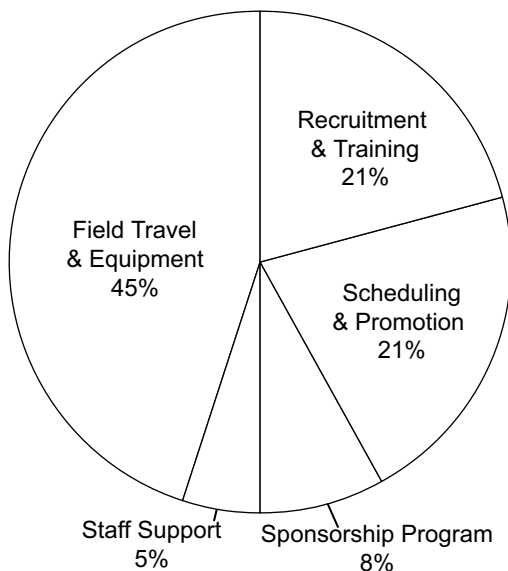
Beginning May 31, provided we have received your list of 60 names, addresses, phone numbers, and your personal letter, Youth Encounter will help offset your personal expenses by providing a monthly stipend. The stipend provided for the two months before training will help cover expenses in preparing for team ministry. Sponsorship funds received (not pledged) by the end of the month will determine the following month's stipend. The last stipend will be given during the last full month (July) on the road of your tour. Reimbursement will be according to the following scale:

In addition, one-third of funds received above your respective sponsorship goal (maximum of \$1,000) will be returned to you, if you wish, at the end of your commitment.
